## Instruction Sheet

### READ THROUGH ALL THE INSTRUCTIONS **BEFORE YOU START.**

To construct this kit you will need the following:

- A Modellers knife.
- Glue UHU Clear Adhesive is our favourite.
- 3. A cutting surface a sheet of card or a cutting mat.
- 4. Fine point tweezers to hold the smaller components.5. Metcalfe UltraFine Tip Glue Bottle (Code: MT907)

## GETTING STARTED

# EXTRACTING COMPONENTS FROM SHEETS.

To stop the components from falling off the sheets, they are held secure with small score points.

To release them push the components gently out from the sheet


Store the released components in a separate 'Builders Yard'. This is an area kept away from your working surface, keep the components here until needed. Use a tray or thick piece of card to make your builders yard.

Fig. 1 - TABLE LEGS
To make the instructions clearer, the parts are colour coded in the pictures.


Brown - Table seats

Blue - Table legs

Red - Table top



First slot the table legs under and against the seat inner bar. The tab on the inner bar slots into the table legs.



Leave to one side to let the glue fully set before adding the table top.

**Fig. 2 - TABLE TOP**Carefully align the table top centre to the seats and table legs.



### Fig. 3 - UMBRELLAS

Locate the umbrella sheet.

To create an umbrella, carefully cut out along the outline. Then lightly score the 'triangle' lines. Then glue the tab to the underside of the opposite triangle. Use a piece of wire or a strip modelling rod approximately 15mm long and 1mm diameter as the supporting pole. A paper clip wire will suffice.
